### Red Card Application / Renewal

The red card indicates that a Pilot is in current flying practice and is 'off checks' (ie has reached a stage where he / she may fly solo on certain types of aircraft without an obligatory check flight with an instructor).

In order to remain current a Red Card Holder you must have flown in the previous 3 weeks. A check flight might still be necessary for 'current' pilots at the duty Full Cat Instructor's Discretion.

A newly qualified solo pilot would be expected to have notionally completed 20 solo flights prior to applying for a Red Card.
